Each year SCF's Board of Directors determines if dividends can be paid. Dividends are never guaranteed.

If the Board declares a dividend, policyholders in ASPs may earn a bonus safety dividend in addition to any potential individual policyholder dividend, based on the association's safety success. (The bonus safety dividend is calculated on the total premiums and losses of all participating association members.)

Association Safety Program

a rewarding partnership



The Association Safety Program (ASP) is designed exclusively for SCF Arizona policyholders that are members of trade and business associations, which partner with SCF to make workplaces safer.

The objectives of the program are to help reduce injuries and to keep workers' compensation premiums as low as possible.

At SCF, we want to reward policyholders for keeping their workers safe. We do this with lower rates, and by working with trade and business associations we are able to communicate our safety message more effectively to Arizona businesses.

How it works

Businesses that are members of a partnering association and that are qualified SCF policyholders in good standing can apply for the Association Safety Program.

The respective association will review and qualify the policyholder's eligibility. Accepted applicants become eligible for a 10 percent rate deviation on their premium. Certain policy groups also are eligible to share in a potential bonus safety dividend in addition to their potential individual dividend.

Each participating ASP member maintains an individual policy and remains responsible to SCF for payroll and premium reporting. The member may have an experience rating (e-mod), which may allow for a premium discount.

Maintaining a low e-mod and a proactive safety program helps policyholders keep their workers' compensation costs in check.

Safety comes first:

- An active, unified approach to accident prevention can mean larger potential savings for members.
- Through ASP membership, small- and medium-sized employers can participate in safety programs that usually are reserved for larger businesses.
- Increased membership in associations creates a larger pool of businesses and people from which to draw when creating safety committees and for beneficial safety training events.
- SCF Arizona's loss control consultants work with policyholders on identifying and fixing potentially hazardous situations to create safer workplaces.

It is fully understood that:

- (1) I must be an SCF Arizona policyholder and a member in good standing of the above named association to enroll in the Association Safety Program, and I must maintain my SCF policy the entire time of enrollment.
- (2) The dividend received by a participating policyholder may be more, but not less than the dividend such participating policyholder would have received from SCF Arizona had the policyholder not been a member of the Program.
- (3) The Association is authorized to obtain premium and loss information from SCF Arizona pertaining to the above-numbered policy and the Association shall have the sole authority to determine the eligibility of the member to participate in the Program or to continue participation in the Program.
- (4) In the event the policy of a participating member is canceled by SCF Arizona for nonpayment of premium, this assignment shall become null and void and neither premium nor losses for the period will be included in the dividend calculation for the Association.
- (5) Dividends payable to a participating member, including the amount of "bonus" dividend, if any, shall be credited by SCF Arizona against the amount of any unpaid premium indebtedness of the member before any portion of the member's individual or "bonus" dividend entitlement shall be paid to the member.
- (6) This enrollment shall remain in full force and effect unless canceled by the Association or member, or the member transfers to a different Association Safety Program.
- (7) Retrospective Rating, Assigned Risk, Self-Rater and Employee Leasing policies are not eligible to participate.
- (8) A participating policyholder, who is removed from the Association Safety Program due to high losses, will not be eligible for enrollment in any Association Safety Program for one year.
