# The Arizona Contractors Association Political Action Committee (ACAPAC)

The decisions of Arizona elected officials affect your business, you and your family. Do you want to have some input on who is elected and show your support of those candidates who are sensitive to your business concerns and those of the construction industry?

The objectives of the Arizona Contractors Association Political Action Committee (ACAPAC) are to make our views known, to help elect those who support our views and to continue to provide input on issues so that the

ultimate votes appropriately reflect our concerns. This is a circle of commitment which provides ongoing communications to policy-makers and elected officials to ensure a healthy environment for all.



## What is ACAPAC?

ACAPAC is an acronym for the Arizona Contractors Association Political Action Committee and will be, hereafter referred to as the PAC. This committee is a committee of the Arizona Contractors Association and is unaffiliated with any particular political party, supporting state and local candidates who have an appreciation and an understanding of construction industry issues.

## Who manages the PAC?

The PAC is administered by a committee formed of ACA Governmental Affairs Committee, which recommends candidate endorsement to the ACA Board of Directors for final approval. The ACAPAC adheres to a set of Bylaws conforming to Arizona and federal law.

## Why should I contribute to the ACAPAC rather than individually?

It is difficult to have a significant impact on the political process as an individual. However, in concert with fellow employers and employees, it is possible to achieve greater impact and ensure that the view of the business community is heard. In turn, the clout of the construction industry will be increased.

## Who does the ACAPAC support?

ACAPAC supports qualified candidates from any political party whose views on matters affecting the construction industry and the business community as a whole reflect the shared interests of ACA members. The candidate should have a realistic chance of winning the election to be considered for endorsement.

## How may I contribute?

Personal contributions may be made directly to the ACAPAC. **Please note that corporate contributions in Arizona are unlawful;** therefore, the PAC can only accept personal checks. Pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes 16-905 individuals cannot give more than \$3,360 in total contributions to a campaign committee or a political committee in a single calendar year.
